 **Christian Formation.** This team will be responsible for Sunday morning Sunday school. The Christian Formation Team will oversee children's youth ministries including VBS and Pioneer Clubs, and adult ministries such as the Women's Bible Studies and other adult small group activities.


 **Mission.** This team will be responsible for oversight of the evangelism partnerships in Greensboro and around the world, including mission budgets, special events, short term mission projects.


 **Trustees.** This team will be responsible for maintenance of the building facility, grounds, and bus. Capital improvements will be made upon Board decision.

 **Worship.** This team will be responsible for worship activities including ushers/greeters, communion stewards/persons who assist in serving communion, persons for offertory prayers, personnel support and planning for special and seasonal services. The team should also be in conversation with staff regarding execution of the service for broadcast as the strategic direction of worship ministries.

 **Evangelism (outreach).** This team will be responsible for planning and executing ministries designed to bring people "one step closer" to a relationship with Jesus Christ and to promote attractive ministries designed to increase church participation and membership.

 **Hospitality.** This team will be responsible for planning special events to celebrate life together at Trinity Church and to oversee the stock and maintenance of the kitchen areas. Special events include seasonal celebrations, receptions, and after funerals.

 **Benevolence.** This team will oversee the use of the benevolent food pantry, and other charitable ministries.

 **Care Ministry.** This team is responsible for visitation, care, and support for Trinity's sick and homebound.

 **Golden Heirs.** This team is responsible for senior ministries activities.
