

Job Description for Director of Youth Ministry

- Build a youth program at an established church
- Recruit and mentor middle and high school youth already participating in the ministries of Trinity Church and those not yet attending Trinity Church.
- Plan, implement, and attend weekly activities for the youth during the school year that include Bible study, worship, fellowship and fun! The activities need to be relevant and effective in instructing, training, nurturing, and equipping youth for leading a Spirit-filled life of faith and forging deep Christian friendships.
- Establish regular meeting times with middle and senior high youth- These meetings may be Sunday evening, Wednesday evening, Sunday morning or other times. Calendar shall be planned in consultation with the Pastor and Christian Formation Team.
- Select curriculum and planning the program for meeting times with attention to Christian formation through teaching and discussion, worship, and recreation.
- Plan special events for youth and work with Christian formation team to involve youth in annual ministries such as Vacation Bible School.
- Encourage and help facilitate full inclusion of the youth into complete Church life (worship services & events).
- Take a lead role in teaching Sunday School/Discipleship classes for middle and high school students.
- Communicate to the church membership and the families of our youth through social media and other means of church communication- our webpage, bulletins, newsletters, etc.
- Regular attendance at services of worship on Sunday and participation in intergenerational church life when possible.

Qualifications

- Faith in Christ and desire to share that faith
- Ability to “connect” and communicate with middle and high school students and their parents
- Ability to plan and execute youth activities that include Christian teaching, worship, and recreation.
- Be proficient in teaching the truths of the Bible to youth in a relevant and engaging way
